**A LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS
AND AUTHORIZING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
FORMATION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 50.**

Resolution No. 98 - 01

WHEREAS, an application for the proposed formation of a County Service Area was filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission pursuant to the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985;

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer of the Commission has examined said application, has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said application in the form and manner provided by law, and has reviewed said application, has prepared a report, including his recommendation thereon, and has presented the same before this Commission for consideration;

WHEREAS, the public hearing by the Commission was held on January 29, 1998, being the time and date and at the place specified in said Notice of Public Hearing, and at such hearing this Commission heard and received all written protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented, or filed;

WHEREAS, said territory includes approximately 166 acres, and is uninhabited, the boundaries set forth in the description of territory proposed for the County Service Area as shown in Exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, the services to be performed by the County Service Area shall be:

- 1. Maintenance of streets/roads
- 2. Maintenance of drainage facilities
- 3. Maintenance of street lighting
- 4. Maintenance of recreation facilities
- 5. Maintenance of open space/farmland
- 6. Extended Police protection
- 7. Extended Fire protection
- 8. Maintenance of water and sewer services


WHEREAS, the Commission hereby determines pursuant to Section 56842 of the Government Code that there will be no exchange of property tax revenues as a result of this County Service Area Formation;

WHEREAS, the Commission has, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, found that the applicant has satisfactorily completed the required environmental review;


