**Solid Waste Diversion Plan requirements.** An owner shall submit to the San Benito County Integrated Waste Management Department, a debris recovery plan prior to the issuance of the building or demolition permit. The debris recovery plan must include the following information: (a) A description of the management methods planned to be used for all types of construction and demolition debris (e.g. reuse, recycling or disposal), (b) The name of all service providers and/or facilities to be used for debris management, (c) An acknowledgment that the owner understands the requirements of this Chapter, including the requirement for demonstrating achievement of the diversion requirement. Diversion requirement means at least 50% by weight of the total construction and demolition debris is diverted.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I am responsible for complying with the requirements of Ordinance 834 (Chapter 15.01.046 of County Code) related to recovery of construction and demolition debris and that lack of compliance may result in delays in issuance of building/demolition permit(s), hold on final inspection(s) and/or fine(s).
